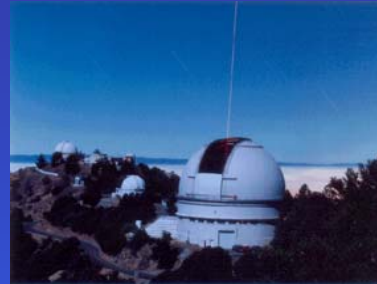


Center for Adaptive Optics

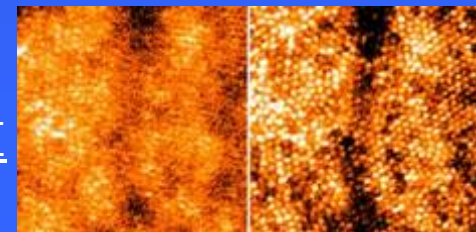
